

LOUISIANA CLAIMANTS EXPECTING TO RECEIVE UNEMPLOYMENT CHECKS

The Louisiana Department of Labor is starting to mail UI benefits to claimants who have relocated to Texas. This requires that the United States Postal Service have the correct addresses for everyone expecting to receive payments.

To ensure your benefits get to you without delay, read below.

- If you filed a claim using a Louisiana address and *can not return to that address at this time,*
- OR**
- If you filed a claim using a Texas shelter or other temporary Texas address *from which you have moved,*

You should file a change of address with the US Postal Service that includes your former Louisiana address, and your newest TEXAS address. This can be done in person at any post office or online at:

The USPS will be able to find you if it has your former address and a correct current address on file. The right address will help your benefits get to you without delay!
